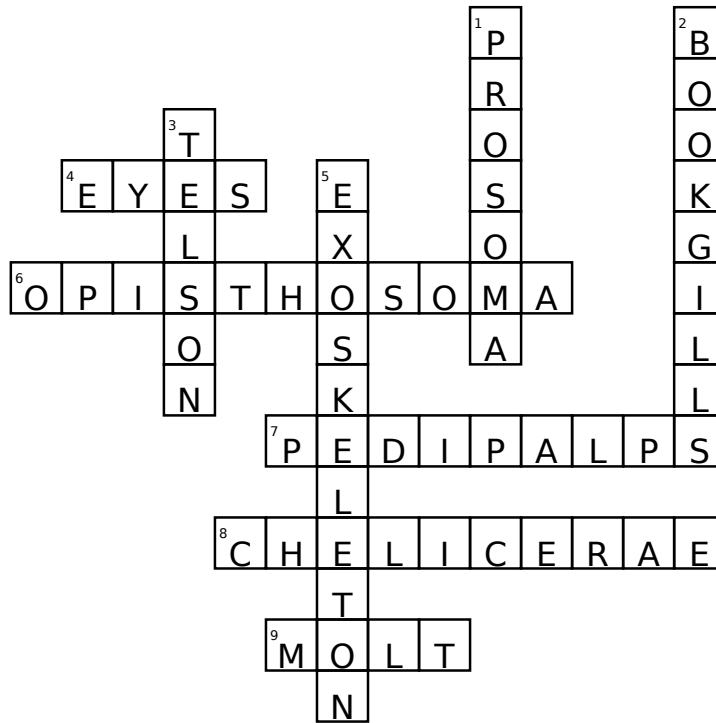


Horseshoe Crab FUN



Down:

1. The head.
2. Similar to lungs, this is how the horseshoe crab breaths.
3. Tail of the horseshoe crab that is NOT used for protection, but instead to help it turn itself back over if it gets knocked upside down.
5. This creature has NO BONES, and instead uses this hard _____ to keep it safe from predators.

Across:

4. Horseshoe crabs have 10 of these (2 noticeable compound ones, and 8 simple ones)
6. The abdomen region.
7. The first set of legs on the horseshoe crab.
8. These features are what make horseshoe crabs related to spiders and scorpions. They also aid in feeding.
9. Horseshoe crabs do this about 18 times in their life. Each time they increase in size by about 25%.
