



Facilities Internship

Purpose

To provide practical hands on experience in facility and grounds maintenance though basic electrical, HVAC, plumbing, mechanical, grounds and trail maintenance.

Objectives

- Assist facilities manager with maintenance operations
- Assist with grounds and trail maintenance
- Assist with other facility tasks as needed

Project Description

The facilities maintenance internship is designed to introduce and teach skills dealing with basic electrical, HVAC, plumbing, mechanical, grounds and trail maintenance. The work will allow for understanding of electrical and mechanical functions of commercial facility equipment, preventive maintenance, repairs, and installation. Combined with grounds maintenance, trail construction and maintenance.

Requirements

- 8-12 weeks/40 hours per week
- Physical ability to work outdoors in summer heat and lift objects up to 50 lbs
- Function as a team member of the Marine Extension and Georgia Sea Grant faculty, staff, and intern team
- Must satisfy all requirements for seasonal, temporary hourly employee of the University of Georgia OR undergraduate student worker. Undergraduate student workers must be enrolled in classes prior to and post internship and be able to provide enrollment documentation
