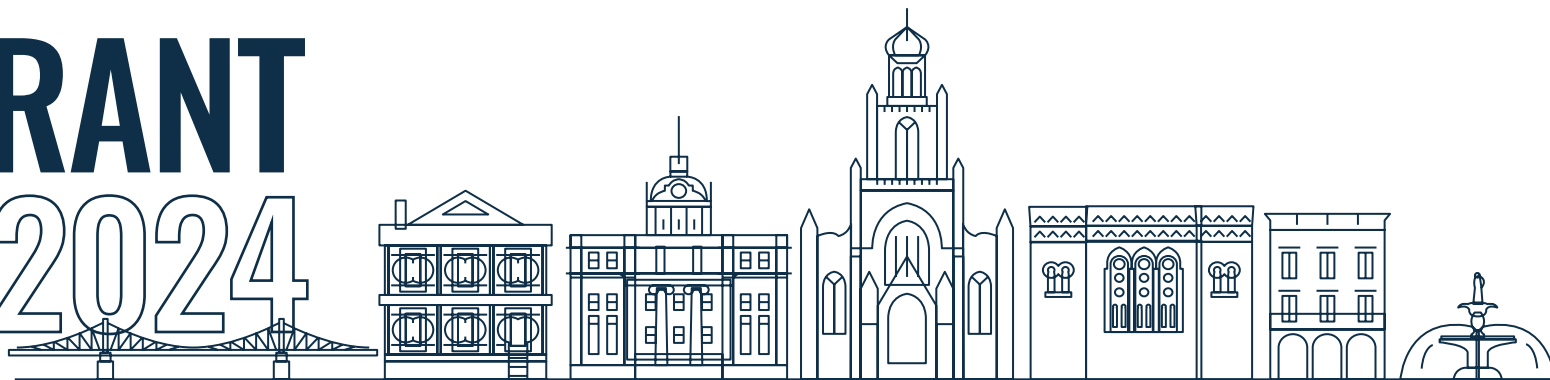

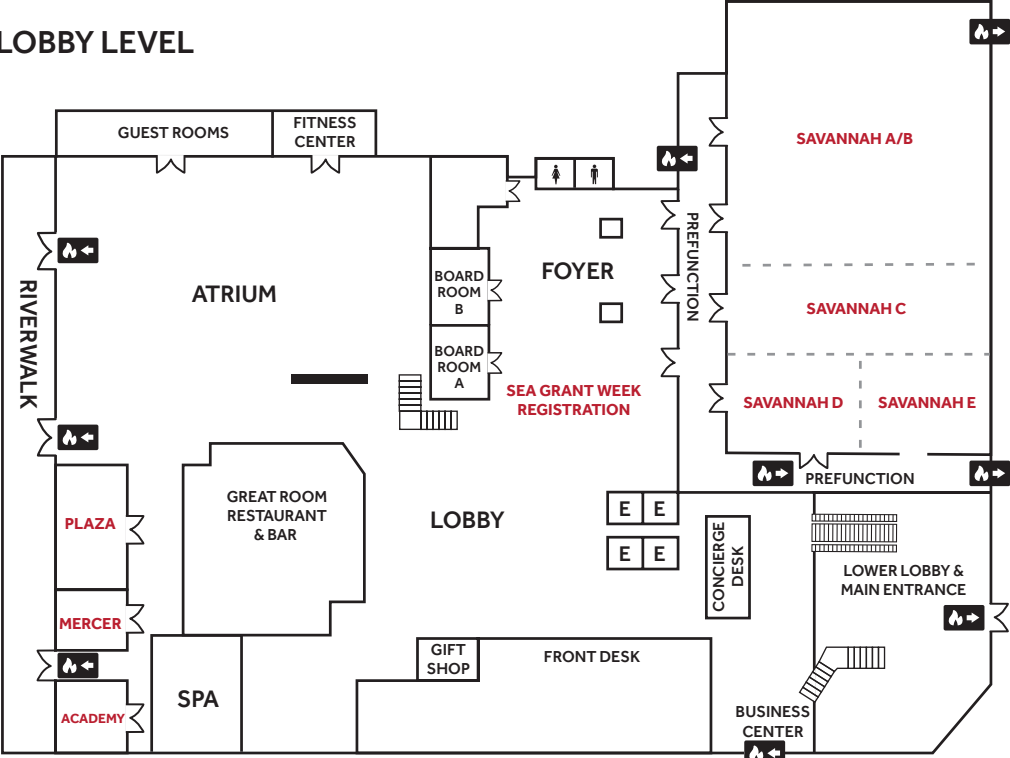

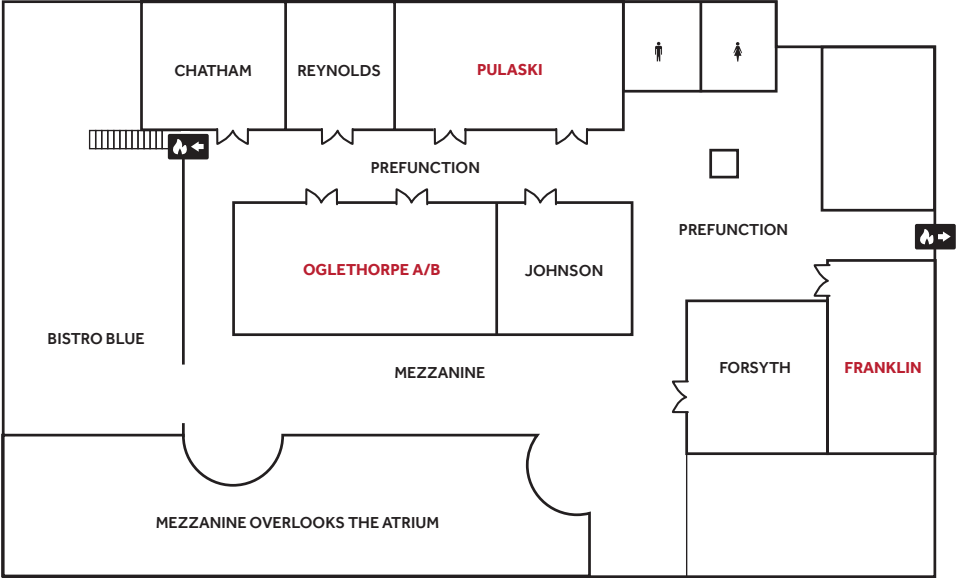

MARRIOTT SAVANNAH RIVERFRONT FLOOR PLAN

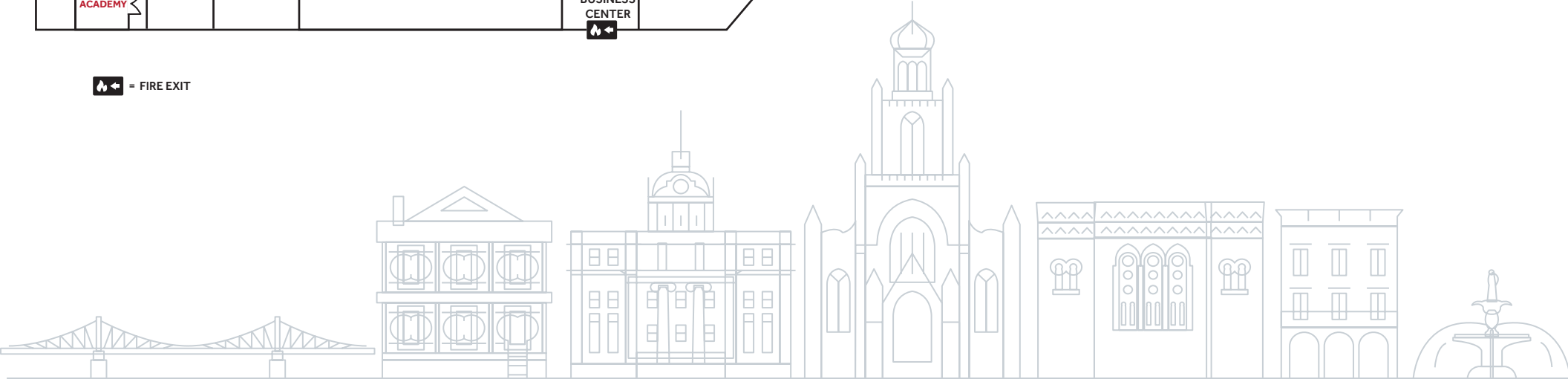
LOBBY LEVEL
